A	彩色自由題材組(PID Color)	不限主題任何題材，接受以創作手法為題材之作品。僅接受彩色作品。
B	黑白自由題材組(PID Monochrome)	不限任何主題、題材，接受以創作手法為題材之作品，僅接受黑白作品。 一幅能夠給予觀眾它沒有任何顏色(即只由從純黑到純白的不同影調所構成)的感受，或是看上去是一副被完全調整為具有單一顏色(例如黑、紅、金色等非灰色的顏色)的灰度照片，稱其為黑白/單色照片。 一張灰度或彩色的照片，通過通過局部調整色調、多處調整色調或者點著色的方式進行修改，是不符合黑白單色定義的，應被視為彩色作品

C	自然組(ND)	<p>FIAP/PSA 自然組定義</p> <p>除了人類學和考古學外，自然攝影記錄了自然史的所有分支。這包括自然界的所有方面，無論有無生命，只要沒有受到人為改造。自然組的影像必須傳達所拍攝場景的真實性。一個見多識廣的人應該能夠識別出影像的主題，並滿意它已被忠實地呈現，並且沒有用不道德的行徑來控制主體或捕捉影像。任何直接或間接人為活動而威脅到被攝者的生命或福祉是不允許的。</p> <p>自然組影像最重要的部分是它所講述的自然故事。高技術水平是應被預期的，影像必須看起來自然。在調整圖像過程中添加暗角或把背景弄朦朧是不允許的。</p> <p>只有當它們是自然故事的必要部分時，自然組的畫面中才可出現人類創造的物體和人類活動的證據。</p> <p>人工創造的雜交植物、栽培植物、逸出或棄養的動物、家畜、人工雜交出的動物，以及裝裱或保存的動物標本都是不允許的。</p> <p>拍攝受控制條件下的主體是允許的，例如動物園。</p> <p>不允許為了拍照而以冷凍、麻醉或任何其它方式限制活體生物的自然移動。</p> <p>不允許任何改變自然影像真實性的修改。除影像可以裁切之外，不可以用影像後製來移除、添加或挪移影像中的任何元素。</p> <p>去除相機所添加的元素，例如灰塵斑點、噪點和鏡頭光暈的技術是允許的。</p> <p>允許將彩色影像完全轉換為灰階單色，但不接受局部轉換顏色、調色和用紅外線拍攝或轉換。</p> <p>允許使用相機或軟體的焦點堆疊(focus stacking)方式拍攝同一主體。允許使用混合曝光(exposure blending)輸出的影像。連續拍攝有重疊區域的多個影像，允許使用相機或影像軟件拼接 (image stitching) 。</p> <p>邊框：參加本沙龍的自然組數位檔案，如果添加邊框，必須是白色或灰色的單個邊框，並且寬度不能超過 3-5 像素。</p> <p>請注意：PSA 關於主題的聲明適用所有組別</p>
D	旅遊組(PTD)	<p>旅遊攝影作品必須能自然地表達當地的明顯特點或文化。作品沒有地域限制。影像來自為了攝影而專門安排的活動、表演，或被拍攝者因為攝影而被導演或僱用是不恰當的。無論人或物的特寫都必須包含可供辨識的環境說明。除了裁切之外，任何使用添加、移位、替換，或移除原始影像元素的技巧都是不允許的。允許移除相機入塵、數位雜訊以恢復影像的原始面貌。可以將彩色影像全部轉換成灰階單色影像。其他衍生作品（包含紅外線在內）是不允許的。所有允許的調整都必須顯得很自然。</p>

主題聲明適用所有組別

有一條基本規則，我們必須時刻遵守其精神，並且適用於 PSA 或 FIAP 認證下國際沙龍的所有組別。拍攝對象的福利比照片更重要。這就是說，為了獲得照片而用活生物作誘餌，或把鳥類從巢中移走的作法是極不道德的，這種照片在 PSA 或 FIAP 認證下的國際沙龍是不允許的。

在任何情況下，都不得為了獲得照片而將生物置於會被殺死、受傷或受到壓力的環境中。無論在影像中是否可見生物被殺、受傷或受到壓力此規則均適用。

PSA 航拍政策

該政策涵蓋所有形式的航空攝影。參加 PSA 認可的展覽的參賽者必須遵守拍攝圖像所在國家/地區與航空攝影相關的所有相關法律和法規。

所有通過航拍拍攝的圖像必須符合 PSA 主題聲明。展覽代表認為不符合 PSA 航空攝影政策的圖像將受到調查，這可能會導致取消資格並將參賽者報告給道德審查委員會。

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

IMAGE AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS This exhibition is open to anyone; however, an entry may be rejected when the Sponsor or the Exhibition Organizers, in their reasonable discretion, believes the entry does not conform to exhibition rules and these Conditions of Entry. Membership in any photographic organization is not required.

Image Creation

Entries must originate as photographs (image-captures of objects via light sensitivity) made by the entrant on photographic emulsion or acquired digitally.

Certification

By virtue of submitting an image, the entrant certifies the work as his or her own (Images may not incorporate elements produced by anyone else (for example: clip art, images or art by others downloaded from the Internet). Aliases are not allowed. The entrant permits the sponsors to reproduce all or part of the entered material free of charge for publication and/or display in media related to the exhibition. This may include low resolution posting on a website. Note: Entrants who indicate that their images may not be reproduced or used “will not be eligible for awards” or inclusion in audio-visuals of the exhibition “and could be subject to disqualification” by the exhibition sponsors. The exhibition assumes not liability of any misuse of copyright.

Alteration and Computer Generation Subject to Divisional restrictions (particularly Nature, Photo Travel, and Photojournalism) images may be altered, either electronically or otherwise, by the maker. Adjustments to enhance images or creatively modify images are allowed providing the underlying photograph is retained in a way that is obvious to the viewer. Images may not be constructed entirely with a computer, and must be the sole work of the. All parts of the image have to be photographed by author who is holding the copyright to all works submitted.

Entry: An Entry consists of, up to and including, four (4) images entered by a single Entrant into the same section. An entrant may only enter a specific Section once.

Titles

Each image must have a unique title. That unique title must be used for entry of that image or of an Identical Image into any and all FIAP-Recognized exhibitions. Titles must be 35 characters or fewer. No titles may be visible to the judges, and nothing in the image may identify the maker. Titles must not include file extensions such as .jpg or .jpeg (or any other camera capture filenames), or words such as “untitled” or “no title”. Titles may not consist solely of numbers.

Color and Monochrome:

Color and Monochrome images from the same capture that share substantial pictorial content in common will be considered the same image and must be given the same title.

Submission: Images and a completed entry form must be submitted on line using the exhibition website. *Entrants **MUST use only the English alphabet when submitting an entry.***

- a) **File size:** All images are to be submitted in **JPEG** format. It is recommended that images should use **RGB** Colour Space. Smaller images are acceptable but will be projected smaller on the screen. Please check all image sizes before submission, images with sizes greater than specified **will be rejected**. *The projection background is black, Please **DO NOT** fill empty space with/or add large borders. Any borders should be no greater than 2 pixels wide.*
- b) **File Naming:** Files must be renamed to the photo title when submitting an entry. However, the titles should appear on the entry form as you wish them to appear in the catalogue.
An image may be entered in only one section where acceptances of that image in multiple sections would be eligible for the same star path.
- c) **Judging:** Entries are limited to not more than 4 images per section. An entrant's images will not be presented to the judges consecutively. An entrant's four images will be distributed throughout four rounds of judging in that section. Distribution of images will be in the same round order as submitted by the entrant. Judging will be done using **ASUS HDTV & Judgment® Software** (made by **Focus Team Software Group**, especially to judge Digital exhibitions). *Judging will be taken place by a jury of 3 judges together for each section.*

DATA PROTECTION

By entering this exhibition, you are explicitly consenting to the personal details you have supplied, including email addresses, being held, processed and used by the exhibition organizers for purposes associated with this exhibition. You also explicitly consent to such information being sent to organizations that have accorded official recognition, patronage or accreditation to this exhibition. You acknowledge and accept that entering this exhibition means that the status and results of your entry may be made public.

BREACHES OF RULES

PSA

In order to ensure that images comply with the Condition of Entry and definitions, the exhibition organizers may carry out reasonable measures to verify that:

- a) the images are the original work of the entrant and
- b) the images comply with the rules and definitions as set out in these Conditions of Entry.

These steps include, but are not limited to questioning any entrant, requiring the submission of RAW files or other digital files representing the original capture of the submitted image(s), confronting the entrant with evidence that one or more submitted images fails to comply with the Conditions of Entry (also known as Entry rules), and offering the entrant a reasonable opportunity to provide counter evidence to refute

the exhibition organizer's evidence by a set deadline. Such entries that are not cleared or are still questionable after the entrant has presented evidence may be considered in breach of these Conditions of Entry, and declined.

PSA retains the right to investigate in any way all complaints/suspicious of breaches of entry conditions, impose sanctions if deemed necessary, void the acceptances of any image found to violate the PSA rules, include the entrant's name on the list of sanctions provided to Exhibitors, and share such investigations with FIAP. Entrants automatically agree to these terms by the act of entering the Exhibition and agree to cooperate with any investigation.

If another party is submitting images on the entrant's behalf, the entrant will still be held responsible for adhering to these Conditions of Entry (Entry Rules) **and will be subject to sanction for any violations** to these Conditions of Entry and PSA's Statement of Ethics that may result.

FIAP:

The entrant that by the sole act of submitting his/her images or files to a salon under FIAP Patronage, the entrant accepts without exception and with no objection the following terms:

- that the submitted images can be investigated by FIAP to establish if these obey to FIAP regulations and definitions even if the entrant is not a member of FIAP,
- that FIAP will use any means at its disposal for this undertaking,
- that any refusal to cooperate with FIAP or any refusal to submit the original files as captured by the camera, or failure to provide sufficient evidence, will be sanctioned by FIAP,
- that in case of sanctions following the non-compliance with FIAP regulations, the name of the entrant will be released in any form useful to inform the breaches of the rules.

It is recommended to leave the EXIF data in the submitted files intact in order to ease eventual investigations. If, at any time, it is determined in the reasonable discretion of the exhibition organizer or the judges before, during, or after the judging of an exhibition that an entrant has submitted entries where one or more images may fail to comply with these Conditions of Entry, including the stated definitions, the exhibition organizers reserve the right to delete the entry from the exhibition and void any or all acceptances or awards in connection with the exhibition. Fees may be forfeited or refunded in these circumstances. The entrant acknowledges that the decision of the exhibition organizers or the judges is final.

DEFINITIONS

All entries shall conform to the stricter of these definitions for acceptances and awards to be validated by all the International Organizations granting recognition or patronage.

Salon Definitions:

In open sections, entrants can enter photos with any kind of theme: for example: portrait, people, nature, wildlife, landscape, architecture, still-life photography, digital imaging, HDR photos, etc. All acceptance eligibility shall be in accordance with the PID Star Ratings or the Galaxy/Diamond Ratings requirements as appropriate.

Monochrome images may not be entered in the Open Color Section. Acceptances in PID recognized Monochrome sections shall be credited towards PID Monochrome Star Ratings and Who's Who Monochrome listings. The color and monochrome versions of same image, regardless of title, cannot entered in different sections of this exhibition.

People Definition: Show us people in all situations, such as daily life, street photography, traditions, portrait, people at work, social events, human relations and etc. The main subject in the photo must be one or more human.

Statement on Subject Matter applicable to all sections

The fundamental rule that must be observed at all times and applies to all sections offered in exhibitions with FIAP patronage or PSA recognition is that the welfare of living creatures is more important than any photograph. This means that practices such as baiting of subjects with a living creature and removal of birds from nests, for the purpose of obtaining a photograph, are highly unethical, and such photographs are not allowed in any exhibition with FIAP patronage or PSA recognition. Under no circumstances may a living creature be placed in a situation where it will be killed, injured or stressed for the purpose of obtaining a photograph. This rule applies regardless of whether or not the creature being killed, injured or stressed is visible in the captured image.

Entry into any PSA recognized exhibitions is conditional on accepting this policy and all other policies stated in the Exhibition's rules. If, in the opinion of the judges and chair of an exhibition, this policy on welfare has not been followed, then the exhibition will refer the matter to the PSA Ethics Review Board which will investigate whether any penalties should be applied to the entrant concerned.

PSA AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

This policy covers all forms of aerial photography. Entrants in PSA recognized exhibitions must comply with all relevant laws and regulations associated with aerial photography in the country in which the image was taken.

All images captured by aerial photography must comply with the PSA Statement on Subject Matter. Images, that in the view of Exhibition representative, do not comply with the PSA AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY will be subject to investigation which could result in disqualification and the entrant being reported to the Ethics Review committee.

FIAP Definitions:

Monochrome:

A black and white work fitting from the very dark grey (black) to the very clear grey (white) is a monochrome work with the various shades of grey. A black and white work toned entirely in a single color will remain a monochrome work able to stand in the black and white category; such a work can be reproduced in black and white in the catalogue of a salon under FIAP Patronage. On the other hand a black and white work modified by a partial toning or by the addition of one color becomes a color work (polychrome) to stand in the color category; such a work requires color reproduction in the catalogue of a salon under FIAP Patronage.

Traditional Photo

A traditional photograph maintains the original image content with minimal adjustments which should not alter the reality of the scene and should appear natural. Rearranging, replacing, adding to or removing any part of the original image except by cropping is strictly forbidden.

PSA Definitions

Color Open:

Monochrome images may not be entered in PID Color sections.

Monochrome:

An image is considered to be Monochrome only if it gives the impression of having no color (i.e. contains only shades of gray which can include pure black and pure white) OR it gives the impression of being a grayscale image that has been toned in one color across the entire image. (For example by Sepia, red, gold, etc.)

A greyscale or multi-colored image modified or giving the impression of having been modified by partial toning, multi-toning or by the inclusion of spot coloring does not meet the definition of monochrome and shall be classified as a Color Work. Monochrome images may be entered for Photo Travel but only the first sentence of the Mono definition applies. Toned images are not permitted for these divisions.

Photo Travel:

A Photo Travel image expresses the characteristic features or culture of a land as they are found naturally. There are no geographic limitations. Images from events or activities arranged specifically for photography, or of subjects directed or hired for photography are not appropriate. Close up pictures of people or objects must include features that provide information about the environment.

Techniques that add, relocate, replace or remove any element of the original image, except by cropping, are not permitted. The only allowable adjustments are removal of dust or digital noise, restoration of the appearance of the original scene, and complete conversion to greyscale monochrome. Other derivations, including infrared, are not permitted. All allowed adjustments must appear natural.

PSA/FIAP Nature Definition

Nature photography records all branches of natural history except anthropology and archaeology. This includes all aspects of the physical world, both animate and inanimate, that have not been made or modified by humans.

Nature images must convey the truth of the scene that was photographed. A well-informed person should be able to identify the subject of the image and be satisfied that it has been presented honestly and that no unethical practices have been used to control the subject or capture the image. Images that directly or indirectly show any human activity that threatens the life or welfare of a living organism are not allowed.

The most important part of a Nature image is the nature story it tells. High technical standards are expected and the image must look natural. Adding a vignette or blurring the background during processing is not allowed.

Objects created by humans, and evidence of human activity, are allowed in Nature images only when they are a necessary part of the Nature story.

Photographs of human-created hybrid plants, cultivated plants, feral animals, domesticated animals, human-created hybrid animals and mounted or preserved zoological specimens are not allowed.

Images taken with subjects under controlled conditions, such as zoos, are allowed.

Controlling live subjects by chilling, anaesthetic or any other method of restricting natural movement for the purpose of a photograph is not allowed.

No modification that changes the truth of a Nature image is allowed. Images may be cropped but no other technique that removes, adds or moves any part of the image is allowed.

Techniques that remove elements added by the camera, such as dust spots, digital noise and lens flare are allowed.

Complete conversion of colour images to greyscale monochrome is allowed. Partial conversion, toning and infrared captures or conversions are not allowed.

Images of the same subject that are combined in-camera or with software by focus stacking or exposure blending are allowed. Multiple images with overlapping fields of view that are taken consecutively and combined in-camera or with software (image stitching) are allowed.

Borders: For the purpose of this exhibition any border added to a Nature digital file must be a single border of white or grey, no greater than 3 -5 pixels in width.

Love Theme (PID Color):

Any work that can express "love" is fine

Open Woman (PID Color) section:

Any subject that is capable of expressing femininity, accepts works based on creative techniques, and is color or monochrome.

PSA Statement on Subject Matter

There is one hard and fast rule, whose spirit must be observed at all times and applies to all sections offered in PSA recognised exhibitions.

The welfare of the subject is more important than the photograph.

This means that practices such as baiting of subjects with a living creature and removal of birds from nests, for the purpose of obtaining a photograph, are highly unethical, and such photographs are not allowed in any PSA exhibitions.

There is also a PSA policy on the use of aerial photography - aircraft, helicopters and drones. This policy can be found at <https://psa-photo.org/index.php?psa-policies#drone>.

The purpose of this policy is to prevent any interference with other individuals or animals which will or may cause a disturbance in their normal activity or disrupt the way any individuals or animals interact with their environment. Entry in this exhibition requires exhibitors to agree to this and other PSA policies

The content of images must comply with these General Conditions and with the Division and Section definitions listed in these conditions. Images that - in the sole opinion of the judges or the Exhibition Organizers - do not comply are likely to be disqualified so the entrant may be aware of the problem when considering entry into other PSA recognized exhibitions.

These are applied to all sections, not just the Nature Section.

Notification of results will be sent by email. Entrants should ensure that they provide an active email address and that spam filters are set to accept emails from pstc.salon@hotmail.com. Notifications will **not** be sent by post. Also you may login to the site using your username and send your result to your personal email using "Result" Key.

By submitting an entry for this salon the entrant permits the organizers to reproduce all or part of the entered material free of charge for publication in a catalogue, on an internet site and/or in other media related to this salon.
